#### **Dear Parents**

In this brochure you will find details of the clubs that will be running in the Spring Term. Please look at the club descriptions with your child and make some choices as to what they might like to do. Please note that clubs are a termly commitment and after the first couple of weeks of term, students should not be requesting to switch clubs. (The only exception to this is Senior Choir which is a yearly commitment).

The booking system will once again be via School Cloud, a programme that many of you will now be familiar with. An information sheet has been emailed to you that provides you with guidance on how the system works and how you can register your child's club preferences. I would advise logging in prior to the clubs sign up opening date in order to check that your login details are working correctly.

#### How to Log in

Visit https://gatewayschool.schoolcloud.co.uk/ and log in with the following information:

You will be asked to enter your contact details.

You will then be asked to enter your child's date of birth. Please also enter the 'Preferred Name' we have on record for your child.

The booking system will open at 8.00pm on Sunday 4 December 2022 and will close at 9.30am on Wednesday 7 December. In order to avoid disappointment, it is important that preferences are submitted by the time the booking system closes.

At this point I would like to highlight that the allocating of clubs will not be done on a first-come-first-served basis. Once the booking system closes students will be assigned to clubs based on their preferences, although not all students will get their first choice clubs. As the academic year progresses, the clubs that students participated in during the previous terms will be taken into account when allocating clubs (especially with regards to the clubs that are in high demand). When picking your preferences, only selecting one club will not guarantee that you will be assigned to that club.

Once all the students have been assigned to clubs, you will receive a confirmation email listing which clubs your child has been allocated to.



#### Important points to note:

- When signing up for Clubs you are expressing your preferences and students will not always be able to have their first choice club. We will monitor the sign up process on a termly basis and will aim to prioritise students who may miss out on a club in one term, with an allocation the following term.
- If your child does not attend a club for 2 weeks, without prior notice being given to the member of staff, their place will be given to the next child on the waiting list.
- Afterschool Activity Club (Reception-Year 3) is an opportunity for the students to take the lead in their choice of activity. They will be able to complete homework, play games, read, draw or simply relax and chat to their peers.
- Homework Club is for Year 4 to Year 6 to complete homework.
- Early morning music clubs Instrument Ensemble, Ukulele and Beginner Recorder have a separate sign up event which is called 'Early Morning Clubs' and you will need to register your child's preference here as well. (this will be found in the same place as the after school clubs event).
- Senior Choir This is a yearly commitment, students who sign up for Senior Choir are expected to attend for all three terms of the academic year. All students who sign up for Senior Choir will automatically be signed up for the Spring Term 2023 and Summer Term 2023.
- First Aid Please be mindful that First Aid Club runs the same program of activities each term. If you have already attended First Aid Club, please do not select this club again.
- Some clubs may run a half term schedule as they are so popular. This ensures
  more children get an opportunity to enjoy this offering each time. This will be
  determined by the number of children signing up. If this is happening it will be
  communicated to you at the same tie as when you receive your confirmation
  email.



### Monday Clubs
